The health services in the Canary Islands are European standard as far as quality goes. The Islands have efficient, modern health facilities: hospitals, medical research centres, primary and geriatric care centres.

There are over **110 primary health care centres** distributed throughout the Archipelago, although most of these health centres are concentrated on the two main islands.

Furthermore, the Canary Islands have **9 public hospitals and 25 private ones**, which care for the resident and floating population to the highest standards of quality and humane care.

Thanks to this infrastructure and the staff available, the people of the Islands can enjoy health services that provide cover for the entire population.
